After taking time to pray and discern, we'd like to share with you our plans of an extended visit for 5 months to Canada (May 1 – September 30, 2017). It has been 3 years since we've been in Canada and we've never stayed more than 8 weeks for a visit. We feel as though it is necessary at this time for us to reconnect with our family, friends and supporting churches.

We are excited because we have a desire to connect on a deeper level with those who have supported us for so many years. An extended visit will allow us to spend more time with our friends and families. However, we are also nervous because we've never done this before and it will require a leap of faith for all the details to fall into place.

We will need a place to live (in the greater Hamilton area), a vehicle to get around, household items and furniture and the funds to pay for all of these things. Especially since we will need to continue to pay our rent and other costs to maintain our place in Nicaragua.



First Cycle of Better Churches Workshop Ends

"What is your best memory from the last six months?" This question began the final dialogue from the first cycle of "Better Churches 1" workshops (June – November 2016), developed by the Nehemiah Center Church Strengthening Department.

Here are two responses from pastors and leaders:

- "My best memory is of the fellowship that we enjoyed with other ministries in the city."

- "For me the best part was participating in the health diagnosis for our church and realizing the elements and vital functions that we need to strengthen."

During the workshop, approximately 60 pastors and leaders accepted the challenge to review five elements and five vital functions of a healthy church in the light of the Bible, in order to later study and apply to their local churches a tool being used by the Church Strengthening Department called "Take your church's pulse."

"In the beginning we were afraid of how the congregations would react to the surveys," said Pastor Jose Daniel Borge, "but after the first work session, all of the leaders were very enthusiastic about the process and were motivated to continue."

We praise the Lord that many of the pastors who participated in the first phase have already used the survey in their congregations, have written an Action Plan to keep growing as a Healthy Church, and have preregistered to continue studying in the "Better Churches 2" workshops.
